Once a thriving community centre for a busy tin and silver mining industry as well as a focus for local beef producers, Liston is on the old Cobb & Co route (Mt Lindesay Road) just inside the NSW/Qld border. Close to the National Parks and situated on Tourist Drive 7, Wilsons Downfall still contains an old Settlers Cemetery although there is no sign of the wattle and daub huts and hotels which were actively supported by the miners.
